Side Letter Between Sweetwater Union High School District and

The Sweetwater Education Association
Regarding Librarian Allocations for the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 School Year
Through the Use of One Time Funding
June 3, 2021

- 1) COVID school closures have impacted libraries and library services in both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school year regarding access to libraries and regarding site sites abilities to recover resources and collections.
- 2) For the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school year only, the District will use ESSER or allowable onetime state or federal funds to fund an additional .2 for school sites for a librarian to provide additional student supports in the library and to assess and recover collections and devices.
 - a. Specifically, as part of the ESSR COVID RECOVERY time, librarians will be tasked with:
 - i. Provide additional supports to students to assist in their acceleration of education.
 - ii. Assess and recover the library collection and student devices or associated fines,
 - iii. Complete all required reporting related to the library, collection and device fees, including but not limited to the monthly and annual principal's report.
 - iv. Complete a Time Accounting Log to account for the time spent under the .2 as set forth above. (District will create a fill in the blank form like previous versions)
- 3) This agreement is not precedential regarding staffing. The District has informed SEA that when one-time funding is exhausted in 2022-2023, it is our intent based on the budget availability to return to the current library allocation (.2 MS, .4 HS).
- 4) The District will convene a library working group to discuss the library of the future, should SEA provide names and request it be convened.
