1. One \$1,000 College Scholarship

Qualifications:

- Graduating high school senior with full-time enrollment
- 3.25 GPA (cumulative) scholarship and 3.0 GPA (cumulative) citizenship – minimum
- Community service with verification from community agency and/or work experience with employment verification from employer and/or Future Educators of America participant
- **Dependent of current S.E.A. member or dependent of a deceased member**

2. One \$1,000 College Scholarship

Ruth French Chapman Scholarship

Qualification:

- Graduating high school senior with full-time enrollment

- Participation in Sweetwater Union High School District fine arts program
- **Dependent of current S.E.A. member or dependent of a deceased member**

3. One \$500 College Scholarship

- 3.25 GPA (cumulative) scholarship and 3.0 GPA (cumulative) citizenship – minimum
- Community service with verification from community agency and/or work experience with employment verification from employer and/or Future Educators of America participant

4. Two \$500 College Scholarships

Qualification:

- Continuing full-time college student
- 2.5 GPA (cumulative) scholarship – minimum
- Community service with verification from community agency and/or work experience with employment verification from employer and/or Future Educators of America participation
- Registered:

In an approved credential or degree program in an accredited institution of higher learning; or as a full-time student in an accredited institution of higher learning.

- **Dependent of current S.E.A. member or dependent of a deceased member**

5. One \$1,000 Scholarship

Qualifications:

- Graduating high school senior with full-time enrollment
- Will attend trade/vocational school or community college
- Community service with verification from community agency and/or work experience with employment verification from employer
